



SENIOR RULE REQUEST FORM

Students entering into their final semester of undergraduate coursework may apply to a College of Engineering Graduate program under the Senior Rule status (Senior Rule status is valid for one semester only) provided they meet the following requirements:

- Minimum overall 3.0 upper division GPA
- Must be enrolled in at least one credit required for completion of their WSU undergraduate degree program, and may enroll in maximum of 16 credits total (undergraduate and graduate credits combined) for the semester
- Must apply for degree by submitting the degree application via Academics by the posted university deadline
- Submit a complete online Application for Graduate Admission
- Fulfill all other Senior Rule requirements as outlined in the WSU Graduate Bulletin (www.bulletins.wayne.edu)
- Submit Senior Rule Request Form signed by the undergraduate Academic Advisor verifying student eligibility
